



MAHJONG IN BOMBAY GYMKHANA FROM SEPTEMBER 1ST, 2024.

Dear Members,

The Managing Committee has considered the request of its Members and approved playing Mahjong in the Gymkhana under the following terms. A show game has been scheduled on Wednesday 4th September, 2024 for which the member coordinator will accept bookings on a first come–first served basis from Gymkhana members only.

1. A maximum of 4 tables accommodating four (4) persons at a time shall be permitted.
2. Of the 16 persons playing, a maximum of 2 guests per table shall be permitted thus taking the maximum permissible number of guests in one session to 8.
3. A venue shall be provided for playing Mahjong based on availability of the space. Hence a fixed venue cannot be earmarked as of now.
4. Up to two days in a week shall be slotted for Mahjong subject to the availability as indicated above.
5. The session may be cancelled for a Gymkhana event/activity/meeting or a member party, if an alternative place cannot be made available.
6. Timing shall be from 2 pm till 6.30 pm on the day of the sessions.
7. Guests have to necessarily be introduced by members on payment of the entrance fee applicable for the day.
8. Apart from the above charges, members introducing guests shall also pay a card room fee of Rs. 200/- GST extra for each guests introduced and this shall be debited to their member account by the Sports dept. on the day of play.
9. Ms. Kavita Hurry has graciously agreed to be the Member co-ordinator for Mahjong @ Bombay Gymkhana and all bookings that need to be intimated to her in advance. Ms. Hurry shall inform the playing members of the modalities put in place to book tables and to communicate within the playing group.
10. These names shall be conveyed by her to the Sports Manager assigned as the point of contact for all Gymkhana related logistics for facilitating the game at the venue.
11. The day/date/venue of next weeks' game shall be decided and intimated by end of the preceding week.
12. Members shall carry their own sets to play with – One per table.
13. Cash transactions for any reason or gambling is strictly not permitted. Tokens being used shall be to keep the score only.



14. At the venue, refreshments shall be made available on charge debited to the member placing the order.

Over time we look forward to making this a competitive game and will encourage members and their guests to play with a full spirit of camaraderie and sportsmanship.

Wishing our Mahjong enthusiasts all the very best and a wonderful beginning to this game at the Gymkhana.
